Lesson 24 – Week of March 30th

1. Mingling and catching up. (10 minutes)

2. Reminder to be courteous, considerate, confessional and confidential.

3. Begin with a short prayer for your time together. (5 minutes)

4. Move to a time of accountability. (20 minutes)

i. **Accountability Questions on your Marriage, Singleness & Family Life**

- Married: Did you love and honor your spouse as Christ commands?
Single: How are you using your singleness to serve the Lord without distraction?
- Married/Parents: Did you pray with and disciple your children in God's Word?
Single: Are you pursuing fellowship so you are not walking alone?
- Have you modeled repentance, forgiveness, and godliness in your household or community?
- Married or Single: Are you guarding against discontentment and trusting God's timing?
(*Discontentment is dissatisfaction with one's circumstance which often comes when we compare our circumstances with others around us*).

ii. **Homework**

- Did you accomplish at least five devotionals last week?
- Did you complete *Foundations for Faith* – Chapter 2?
- Did you read *Can We Trust the Bible*?
- Did you meditate on Westminster Shorter Catechism: Questions 73-75?
- Memorize 1 Peter 4:19 - "Therefore let those who suffer according to God's will entrust their souls to a faithful Creator while doing good."

Lesson time. (55 minutes)

- i. From *Foundations for Faith*, Chapter 2. Read Hebrews 4:12 and answer question 4: Consider Hebrews 4: 12. What do you think it means that God, who is present everywhere, calls his words "living and active"?
 - a. How does God use His Word in your life?
- ii. From question 5, what can we learn from Jesus' encounter with Satan?



- iii. Go over question 11: From these passages, what is the basis for your confidence in the Word of God?
 - a. Joshua 23:14
 - b. Proverbs 30:5-6
- iv. Go over question 21: What principles do you see in Psalm 119:59-60 that relate to applying Scripture to your life?
- v. **From James Emery White’s *Can We Trust the Bible?***: How were you encouraged, challenged or informed by reading this PDF?
- vi. On pages 7-11, White explains how the books of the Bible came to be part of a single canon. How did his explanation help your understanding of the Bible and how it came to be?
- vii. On pages 14-17, White explains the integrity of the Bible by comparing it with other historical documents. How were you surprised by his explanation? How would you explain the integrity of the Bible in your own words?
- viii. On page 25, White gives three principles for interpreting the Bible, are these principles you currently use when you read scripture? If not, which one is new to you.

5. Prayer time (15 minutes) __:30 - __:45
- i. Ask for specific prayer requests from members.
 - ii. Pray for one another as you wish (example, each person prays for the person on their left).
 - iii. Write down these prayer requests so you can follow up in the next meeting.
