- Did you accomplish at least five devotionals this week?
- Did you read chapters 1-2 of *Chosen By God*?

4. Lesson Time. (40-55 minutes)

i. How did chapters 1 and 2 encourage, challenge or inform you?

ii. How familiar are you with the doctrine of predestination? Before reading this chapter, could you define it?

iii. From page 2-3, what do the verses listed (Ephesians 1:4-5, Ephesians 1:11, and Romans 8:29) teach us about the doctrine of predestination?

Answer: That it is a biblical doctrine...and from page 3 “the issue is not whether we should have a doctrine of predestination or not, but what kind we should embrace.

iv. From pages 13-14, If God is not sovereign over everything in the universe, what do we have to conclude?

Answer: That God is not God (top of page 14).

v. From pages 20-21, what are some differences between the reformed and non-reformed view of predestination?

- vi. Is a just and holy God required to extend mercy to every fallen person? Why or why not?
Answer: "God is never, never, never obligated to be merciful to sinners." (Top of page 24)
- vii. From pages 26-27, can autonomy and sovereignty coexist? Explain your answer.
Answer: "It is logically impossible to have a sovereign God existing at the same time as an autonomous creature." (Bottom of page 26)
