Grasping the Big Idea

Challenged to Change

1. When you face fear or discouragement, do you intentionally recall God's past mercies in your life? Why or why not?
2. What specific memories of God's faithfulness could you return to more often as a source of renewed trust?

3. How might you cultivate the discipline of remembering grace—not just casually, but prayerfully and regularly?

Praying for Change

Ask the Lord to help you “remember Him on your bed” and “meditate in the watches of the night” (Psalm 63:6). Pray for a heart that recalls His help in the past and sings for joy in the shadow of His wings, confident that He will be faithful again.
