Leader Preparation Guide

- 1. Pray for you group members throughout the week.
- 2. Look over the agenda and answer all the questions from the chapters you will be covering. Make sure you understand the topic well as you will be leading the discussion in your GraceGroup.
- 3. Fill out the agenda with the particular time in the boxes provided so you can keep track of your time the night you're leading.
- 4. The night you are leading, make sure you:
 - i. Show up a few minutes early
 - ii. Have a copy of your agenda and anything else you may need
- 5. When leading your Post Grad Group, be mindful of those who are talking too much or others who are not talking at all. If necessary, gently encourage anyone who is speaking too much to give room for others to share as well as those who are too quiet, to engage in conversation.

- 7. Once you have completed the agenda, make sure you go over the homework for the following week.
