

so much that he gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish


but have eternal life.

1 Cor 13:4-8

This is real love—not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as a sacrifice to take away our sins.


1 John 4:7-21

Broken view #4: I can't give because I don't have much.
