Four Spiritual Laws


- God Loves you and has a wonderful plan for your life

What if followers of Jesus were better equipped to live like Jesus, embracing, authentically, every interaction?


42 Seconds helps you to live and speak like Jesus in every conversation throughout your day – at the mailbox, over the fence, and in the grocery store.

Be Kind

- Say hi
- Be nice, friendly,
- Look them in the eye, Acknowledge as human
- Acknowledge the people who inhabit the background:
 - Beggars, servants, machine people
- Do something small for them
- Ask a question, ask another question
- Ask a question about who they are
- Do not ask a question that is trying to make a point
- Laugh with a child



Be Present

See the person, look at them, really listen to them
 Hear their story

- Hagar and the Angel of the Lord, Genesis 16:8-
 - Sarah treated her harshly and she fled
 - Where did you come from?
 - Where are you going?
 - You are the "God who see me!"

Be Present

Know this, my beloved brothers: let every person

- be quick to listen,
- slow to speak,
- slow to anger;

James 1:19

Be Present - listen


Rich young ruler : Good Teacher, "what must I do to inherit eternal life?"

Be Present - listen

Real conversation (not pre-scripted pitches) involves really listening to the person and the Holy Spirit

Avoid agendas, formulas, scripted pitches

If there's anything that will kill a healthy lively conversation, it's a pre-conceived agenda



Requires humility:
 meaning see yourself as God sees you
 not better, not worse
 Jesus sermon on the Bread of Life – John 6
 Temptation from the Temple - Luke 4

Be Present: authentic

Be vulnerable

- Jesus in the Synagogue Luke 4 reading Isaiah 61
 - Vs 22: all <u>spoke well of him</u> and marveled at the gracious words
 - Vs 28: When they heard these things, all in the synagogue were <u>filled with wrath</u>.

Consider the way of Jesus:

- Put away your strategy.
- Choose authenticity.
- Be engaged with what's really happening.
- Enjoy each person you meet.
- Show the person in front of you that they mean more to you than your plans.
- You never know what might happen next.
