In January, Missoula Works was chosen to be part of REDF's 2023 Growth Portfolio cohort. 13 high-impact employment social enterprises (ESE) were selected, and each will receive three years of unrestricted grant funding totaling \$300,000, along with three years of customized capacity-building support and advisory services designed to increase their reach, sustainability, and impact as vital centers for equitable workforce development.

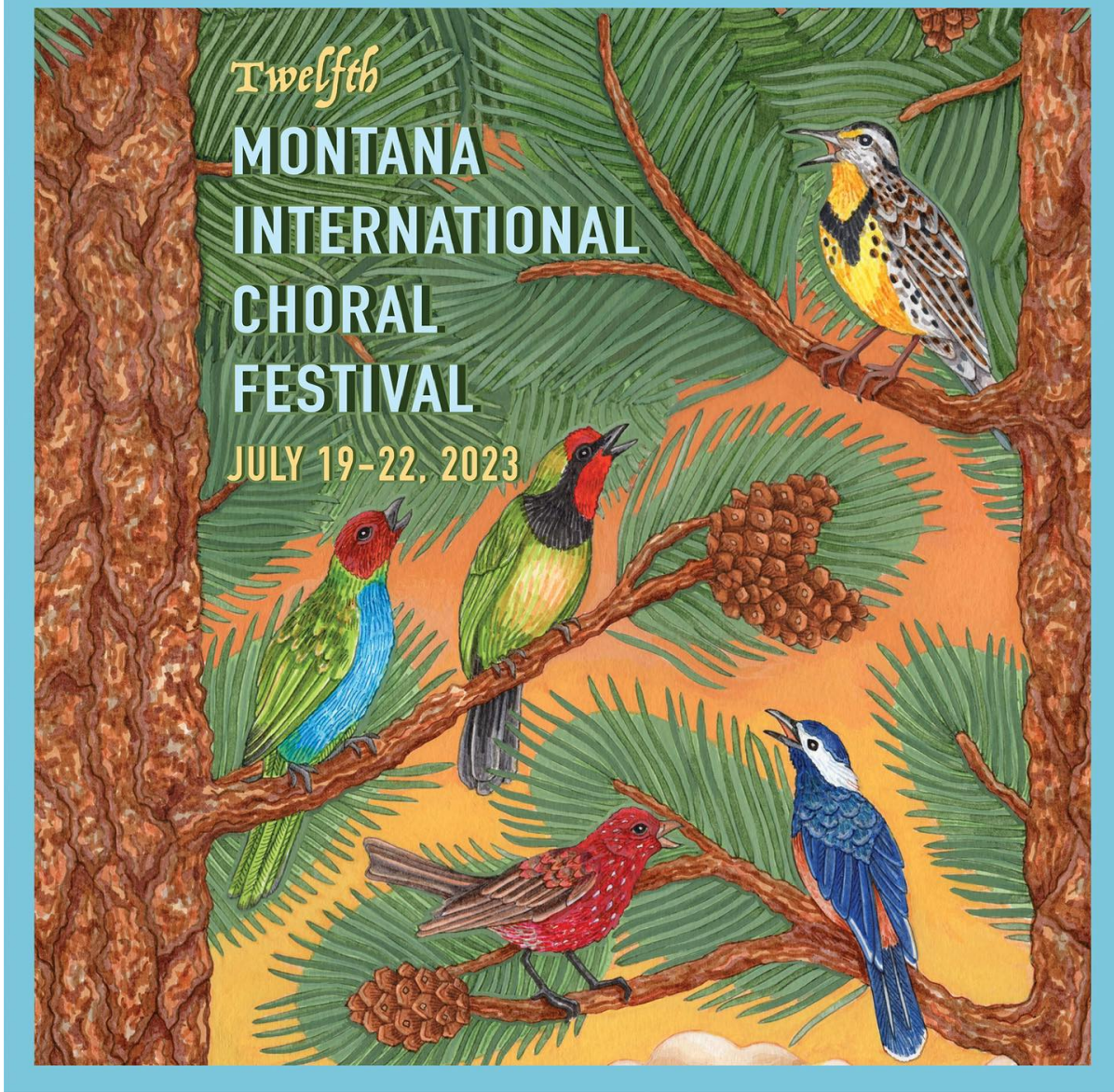
