New leaders offered up new skills in everything from worship enrichment to pastoral care and administration. We were encouraged by what we witnessed, and it built confidence and capacity. One endeavor spurred on another. New energy surfaced, and together we discovered a more collaborative leadership model. Our seeds bore fruit.

As Terri rejoined us she too recognized the growth and momentum. "It was palpable," she said: "It felt like Easter!" And she had no interest in going back, only a desire to help nurture this growth. So together, leaning on the inspiration and guidance of the Holy Spirit, we crafted a plan with support of the Vestry to continue building up this soil and planting new seeds, watching with anticipation. We shifted to a Co-Rector model as part of this effort. How would ministry continue to change and grow?

We have been Co-Rectors now for six months, and we continue to be surprised by the joy of this

**teamwork.** Not only are we able to support each other in our ministry, but the synergy energizes us and feeds that momentum. This diffuse leadership model has nurtured a more robust lay leadership team than ever before. Laity and clergy are more aware of all the ministries in the parish, and we actively look for ways to combine efforts where possible to enrich all that is going on here.

## What does all this mean for our church?

It means that we are stretching and growing and reaching new places like tendrils of pumpkin vines that will not be contained. It means that together we have more energy than we do on our own. Together we have more confidence and courage. Together we have more ideas. Together we can nurture and deepen relationships. Together we can listen and care for one another in ways that were not possible on our own. Together we can shine – shine Christ's light in this world. And then we watch – because who knows what wild thing the Spirit might just grow out of that?
