Life Sharing: (answer one)

1. Did you ever play Hide-n-Seek as a kid? What was your favorite place to hide?
2. What is an area of the world you would like to visit to see how God is changing lives through His people?

3. What kind of parental correction was most effective in your life when you were growing up at home?

Life Examination:

READ Colossians 1:15-29

4. What are the things we learn about Jesus through this passage?
5. What are the words Paul uses to describe our "once you were" and to describe our "but now you are" realities?
6. Verse 23 says, "... if you continue in your faith". What does this mean regarding the security of our salvation?
7. What does Paul mean by "fully mature" in verse 28.

READ Hebrews 1:1-6

8. Why is Jesus a better spokesperson for God, as compared to the Old Testament prophets?
9. What is true about Jesus, according to verse 3?
10. What are some ways that Jesus is superior to angels?
11. Why does this matter to the author of Hebrews?

Life Application:

12. What is a Bible story where Jesus' words or actions reveal what God is like?
13. Have one or two of your group members share about how they moved from "once you were" to "but now you are" in Christ.
14. What are the people, habits, and things in your life that help you move toward "fully mature"?
15. It makes sense that God would speak through His Son, who is perfect and an exact representation. God also speaks through us into the lives of people around us. Why is that hard to believe?
16. What are some ways that God speaks through our lives?
