①→ **All Hallows' Eve — Facing the Night** (Psalm 90, Ephesians 5:8-14, John 1:5)

- ① Why do you think God calls us to face mortality, not to fear it?
- ② Where in your life do you most resist the darkness, and what might it mean to meet Christ there instead of avoiding it?
- ③ When you “number your days,” what changes about the way you spend them?
- ④ How does remembering death sharpen your gratitude for life and deepen your longing for resurrection?

②→ **All Saints' Day — Walking in the Light** (Hebrews 12:1-3, 1 Corinthians 1:2, Matthew 5:3-12, Philippians 2:5-8, Revelation 7:14-17)

- ① How does seeing sainthood as belonging, before achieving, reshape the way you understand holiness?
- ② What does it stir in you to be told that you're part of the same race as Abraham, Rahab, and the saints who came before you?
- ③ Who in your life has lived as part of that “great cloud of witnesses,” steadying your faith when it faltered?
- ④ What does it mean, practically, to “run freer” — to throw off resentment, distraction, or nostalgia that entangles your faith?

③→ **All Souls' Day — Waiting for the Dawn (EXTRA CREDIT)**

- ① How might remembering the dead with hope, rather than fear or sentimentality, reshape the way you live toward eternity?
- ② What does it mean to love someone in Christ who is no longer here — and to believe that love has not ended?
