➡ What “noises” in your life have recently caught your attention spiritually — moments when you sensed God stirring, even when you weren’t looking for Him?

➡ How has God spoken to you through unexpected people or situations, and how did you recognize it as His voice?

➡ Do you tend to approach God as a listener or as a demander? Where in your life are you asking for sight when God might be offering sound?

➡ Why do you think hearing is so central to faith in Scripture — and how do you personally discern God’s voice amid all the other noise? (Romans 10:17; John 10:3–4)

➡ How does our culture’s obsession with proof or certainty challenge your walk with God — and where have you seen faith grow without having “all the evidence”? (Hebrews 11:1; 2 Corinthians 5:7)

➡ What scares or challenges you about slowing down enough to listen deeply — whether to God, to Scripture, or to others?

➡ **EXTRA CREDIT:** How might curiosity — even nosy, imperfect, restless curiosity — become a doorway to deeper faith for you?
