- 2 → How does the certainty of Christ's return reshape how you view your own life right now?

- 4 → What part of Christ's return have you avoided thinking about — especially if past rapture teaching shaped, or shapes, your assumptions?
- 5 → Where has God's "delay" tempted you to interpret it as "absence"?
- 6 → How does the King's return reveal what you truly trust?
- 7 → Where have you gone through the motions of faith without actually risking trust?
- 8 → What is one small act of trust the Spirit is prompting you to take this week?
