Discussion Questions for small group, home fellowship, and family use—drawn from the “God in the Fog” series.

1 → What has this whole series taught you about faith, fog, and following Jesus?

Habakkuk 3:17–19 – “Though the fig tree does not bud... yet I will rejoice in the Lord...”

2 → What’s one thing you still believe—not because it was proven, but because it was lived?

2 Timothy 1:12 – “I know whom I have believed...”

3 → When has Jesus met you in a place where clarity failed—but presence remained?

Mark 9:24 – “I do believe; help me overcome my unbelief!”

4 → How has your understanding of certainty changed?

Proverbs 3:5–6 – “Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding...”

5 → Have you ever felt like the man born blind—unable to argue, but unable to deny?

John 9:25 – “One thing I do know: I was blind but now I see.”

6 → What kind of faith do you have when the fog doesn’t lift?

Hebrews 11:1 – “Faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see.”

7 → Where have you mistaken knowing *about* God for truly knowing *Him*?

1 Corinthians 2:2 – “I resolved to know nothing... except Jesus Christ and him crucified.”

8 → Why is humility essential in a faith that embraces mystery?

Romans 11:33 – “Oh, the depth of the riches... how unsearchable his judgments...”

9 → How can the church become a safer place for mystery, sorrow, and unanswered questions?

Jude 22 – “Be merciful to those who doubt...”

10 → If you could write your own benediction after this series, what would it say?

2 Corinthians 5:7 – “For we live by faith, not by sight.”
