



Foundation 6 | Share Our Story

REVIEW: Last week we looked at the importance of living for Jesus Christ no matter where God places us. Today we will talk about our role in the Great Commission and also have the opportunity to share our personal faith stories.

Crowd-breaker

- If aliens landed on Earth, who would you recommend they talk to?
- If aliens landed on Earth, who would you recommend they NOT talk to?

Introductory Comments

These are funny questions to think about, and we are not advocating for the existence of aliens. But the questions do relate to our final session today: sharing with someone about a person who is important to us and that they should know personally. Today we have the opportunity to share our personal faith stories about how we met Jesus Christ. And the hope after today is that you will continue to find opportunities to share Him with others.

Discussion

1. This week we read that God can save those we may not think possible. What is it within us that causes our doubt or skepticism, and how can we change?
2. Share a time where God used you or another person to turn a normal conversation into a spiritual discussion when you never even considered something like that would happen. What lessons can we glean from that scenario?

In addition to these questions, consider discussing any of the reflective questions from the past week's daily devotional readings as time permits.

Sharing Personal Faith Stories

Each of you wrote your personal faith story prior to coming to today's group session. Let's continue to have us all sit and be casual as we share what our lives were like **before** we met Jesus, **then** how we heard about Jesus, and what our lives have been like **since** trusting

in Christ. Please keep your personal faith story between 3-5 minutes so we can hear from everyone.
