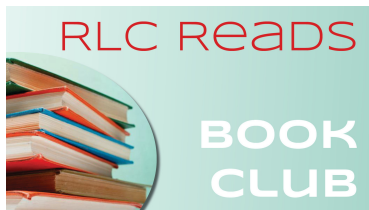


RLC Reads Continues Nov. 13th

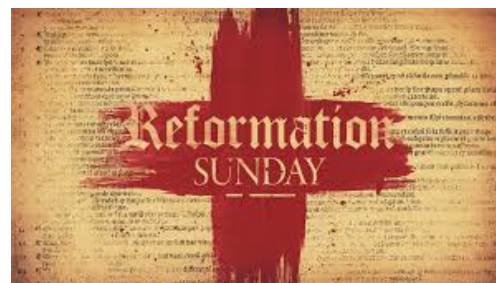

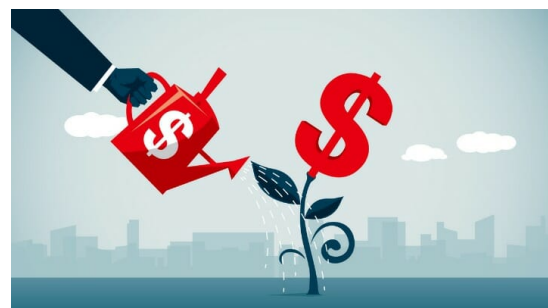

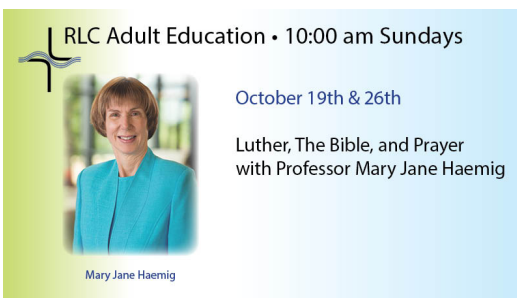
