### Church Security

In an effort to reduce unmonitored & unlocked exterior doors, RLC's Facilities Management has implemented a door policy. The lower level (Door 1) will generally be

LOCKED. For lower level meeting rooms (e.g. Worship Center, Social Hall, Rm 40, Rm 45), DOOR 1 will be UNLOCKED 15 MINUTES EITHER SIDE OF THE START OF A MEETING. The upper level door (Door 2) is unlocked during office hours Monday - Thursday 8:30-3:30pm. After office hours, upper level meeting rooms (e.g. Library, Lounge, Activity Center) will have DOOR 2 (Lobby Door) UNLOCKED 15 MINUTES EITHER SIDE OF THE START OF A MEETING.
