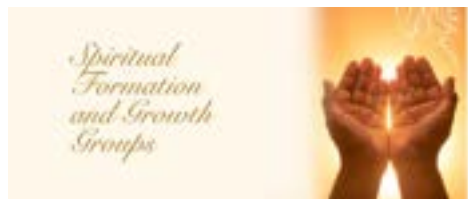
WAPO Registration Is Now Open
