We won't have coffee service on Sunday, 8/31 due to the long holiday weekend.



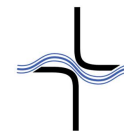

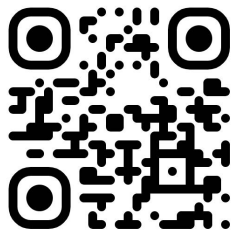
Welcome to the start of our fall ministries and check out all of the ministries, committees, and groups that you can get involved with here at RLC. We will have

Volunteer at the Childcare House:

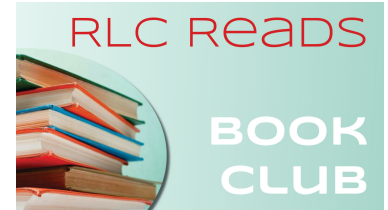

Guatemala Mission Trip March 2026:

Are you interested in a working trip with other members of Roseville Lutheran? RLC has been collaborating with local schools in the mountainous regions of Guatemala to improve their facilities.

Through your donations, RLC is purchasing the supplies for a team of volunteers to build a new kitchen facility for a school in the mountainous area in Guatemala. The trip volunteers will work for about 4 days doing moderate lifting, hauling or carrying to build the kitchen during the trip.

A working kitchen is so important for the support and retention of Guatemala students. If a school doesn't have a functioning kitchen, the students will go home for lunch and often most of the students will not return to school for afternoon lessons. Statistics show that students who go home for lunch, will drop out of school over time and not complete their elementary or secondary school education.

The dates of the RLC Guatemala trip are Saturday March 7 th 2026 to Sunday March 15th 2026. Pastor Marty and Tanner Wyatt will be leading the trip. There are 5 rooms available for the upcoming trip, with one room having 2 beds.
