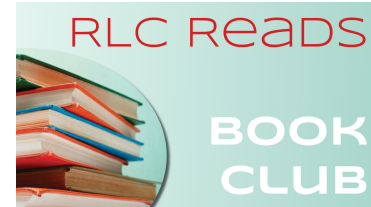
Bible Study:
