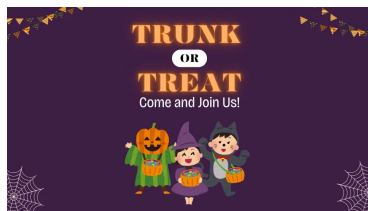
Endowment Grant Requests Due by October 1st

Funding is available for qualifying projects related to faith, worship, discipleship, service, stewardship, evangelism, education, missions and more.

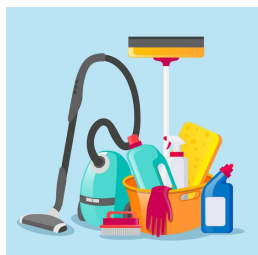

The LWV can be relied upon for accurate information because it is a nonpartisan, grassroots organization dedicated to protecting democracy through advocacy, education, and litigation at the local, state and federal levels.

October 4: Join Professor Mary Jane Haemig for a thoughtful exploration of Martin Luther's understanding of the Ten Commandments. For Luther, the commandments were more than a set of demands. They were also a gift, offering guidance for how God intends human life to be lived.
