

A Worship Discussion Guide for Individuals, Groups & Families for the week of September 29, 2024

Read the Bible passage aloud in your group meeting. This is a worship discussion guide, and our reflections and applications are grounded in Scripture. You do not need to work through the whole guide. Decide which points would be most helpful for your meeting, and use them as a starting point for your time together.

Warm Up

Share about a way someone's words have blessed you recently.

Deuteronomy 33-34

Whom the LORD Knew Face to Face

Read Deuteronomy 33.

 Moses blessed Israel just before his death. Read each tribe's blessing. In your own words, how would you summarize how the LORD blesses each tribe?

Read Deuteronomy 34.

- What final message does the LORD have for Moses on his deathbed? (1-8)
- How is Moses remembered by Israel? (9-12)
- We are told that there was no other leader like Moses.
- We are told of Moses greatness, yet a Prophet greater than Moses would one day appear. This Sunday's New Testament reading gave us insight into how the life of Moses prepares us to know the life of Christ. How does <u>Hebrews 3:1-6</u> describe Jesus as One who is worthy of more glory than Moses?
- Moses was known by the LORD. What does it mean to be "known" by God? What impact does being known by God have on us as followers of Jesus?
- Pray together in response to God's Word.
