



A Worship Discussion Guide for Individuals, Groups & Families for the week of June 14, 2026

Read the Bible passage aloud in your group meeting. This is a worship discussion guide, and our reflections and applications are grounded in Scripture. You do not need to work through the whole guide. Decide which points would be most helpful for your meeting, and use them as a starting point for your time together.

John 3:16 God So Loved

¹⁶“For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.

- In every worship service, we sing songs to God connected to the theme of the liturgy. This week, we sang Samuel Crossman’s 1664 hymn “*My Song is Love Unknown*.” [Listen to the song](#), or [read the lyrics](#). This hymn reflects on the mystery of divine love revealed in the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ. **Does Crossman touch on any aspects of the love of God in Christ that are meaningful to you today? Which ones? Why?**
- Every service at WEPC includes a *Confession of Sin* followed by *Words of Encouragement*. This week’s *Words of Encouragement* come to us from [1 John 4:9-10](#). Read these verses, and consider: **What does God think about how much you love Him?**
- This week, Pastor Steve Shelby preached from [John 3:16](#).
 - **What does God think when He looks at you? How do you know?**
 - **What is the love of God, and what is it like? How do you know?**
- Each Sunday, we participate in the sacrament of the Lord’s Supper. **How does the Lord’s Supper communicate the love of God to His Church?**
- Every service at WEPC includes a *Confession of Sin*. This week, we told the Lord together that we struggle to believe that He loves us, and listed several sins that we use to rebuff His love. **Spend time confessing your sins in prayer. Be specific about the ways you run from your Heavenly Father and succumb to unbelief. Also, confess that God so loved you and so loved the world He gave His only Son.**
- **Pray that hearts at WEPC will be made new.** Ask Him for faith to believe that He so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life. Do you need to become a Christian? Be renewed as a follower of Jesus? To change, believe, or to repent? Hint: The answer is “Yes” and you can ask Jesus to meet you right now!
