



A Worship Discussion Guide for Individuals, Groups & Families for the week of June 28, 2026

Read the Bible passage aloud in your group meeting. This is a worship discussion guide, and our reflections and applications are grounded in Scripture. You do not need to work through the whole guide. Decide which points would be most helpful for your meeting, and use them as a starting point for your time together.

John 3:16 Faith

¹⁶“For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.

- This week, Pastor Kevin Greene preached from [John 3:16](#). **What does Jesus mean by “believe in Him”?**
- Every service at WEPC includes an Old Testament reading that serves as a companion to the sermon text. This week we read [Genesis 15:1-6](#) and saw that faith and belief involve trust.
 - Abram believed the LORD, and God counted it to him as righteousness. **What does that mean?**
 - **How do you need to trust the LORD in this season of life? What challenges do you face as you trust Him?**
- As a part of each Sunday’s communion liturgy, we read Scripture to help us remember that Jesus instituted the sacrament of the Lord’s Supper. This week’s *Words of Institution* come to us from [1 Timothy 3:9](#); [1 Corinthians 5:7-8, 10:16-17, and 15:3-4](#). **As we proclaim the mystery of the faith, the congregation declares that “Christ has died. Christ is risen. Christ will come again.” Why are these truths at the heart of Christian belief?**
- This week in worship, we installed and ordained new and returning church officers—a gift of God to our church. Read [Hebrews 13:7](#). **What strikes you about how church leaders and the church body are described here?** Take time to pray for our leaders and our congregation.
- **Pray that hearts at WEPC will be made new.** Ask Him for faith to believe that He so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life. Do you need to become a Christian? Be renewed as a follower of Jesus? To change, believe, or to repent? Hint: The answer is “Yes” and you can ask Jesus to meet you right now!
