



## A Worship Discussion Guide for Individuals, Groups & Families for the week of July 5, 2026

Read the Bible passage aloud in your group meeting. This is a worship discussion guide, and our reflections and applications are grounded in Scripture. You do not need to work through the whole guide. Decide which points would be most helpful for your meeting, and use them as a starting point for your time together.

### John 3:16 *Eternal Life*

<sup>16</sup>“For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.

- This week, Pastor Steve Shelby preached from [John 3:16](#). **What does Jesus mean by “eternal life”? What is unique about this kind of life?**
- In every worship service, we read an Old Testament passage that is a companion to the New Testament sermon text. This week we read [Isaiah 25:6-9](#). **In Isaiah’s vision, what things are distinctive about eternal life?**
- This Sunday, the young worshippers of WEPC heard a *Children’s Message*. **We believe that children are a part of our covenant community. What value and ministry do children have among us at WEPC? Why do you believe that?**
- This week, we confessed our sins and need of God’s grace using a reading based on [Heidelberg Catechism, Q&A 58-61](#). **Read that confession together now. What do we see about the blessings of eternal life? Spent time in prayer in light of this confession.**
- **Pray that hearts at WEPC will be made new.** Ask Him for faith to believe that He so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life. Do you need to become a Christian? Be renewed as a follower of Jesus? To change, believe, or to repent? Hint: The answer is “Yes” and you can ask Jesus to meet you right now!
