



A Worship Discussion Guide for Individuals, Groups & Families for the week of July 26, 2026

Read the Bible passage aloud in your group meeting. This is a worship discussion guide, and our reflections and applications are grounded in Scripture. You do not need to work through the whole guide. Decide which points would be most helpful for your meeting, and use them as a starting point for your time together.

John 3:31-36 *All Things in Jesus' Hands*

³¹He who comes from above is above all. He who is of the earth belongs to the earth and speaks in an earthly way. He who comes from heaven is above all. ³²He bears witness to what he has seen and heard, yet no one receives his testimony. ³³Whoever receives his testimony sets his seal to this, that God is true. ³⁴For he whom God has sent utters the words of God, for he gives the Spirit without measure. ³⁵The Father loves the Son and has given all things into his hand. ³⁶Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life; whoever does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God remains on him.

- In this passage, John the Baptist continues to talk about Jesus. What words and phrases does John use to describe the person and work of Jesus Christ?
- How does John describe the relationship between God the Father & God the Son?
- John contrasts “receiving” and “believing” the Son of God with “disobedience”. How would one recognize someone who was “believing”, and someone who was “disobedient”? How Does John describe the fruit of each response?
- What is the “wrath of God” (36)? How exactly does the Son of God deliver us from the wrath of God?
- “He whom God has sent utters the words of God, for He gives the Spirit without measure” (34). Jesus has a connection to both the Word of God and the Spirit of God. How would you describe those connections.
- We can trust Jesus for everything we need for life and salvation. How do you need to trust Jesus in this season of your life?
- Pray together in light of this week’s passage.



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
