CAITLIN'S SMILES

The mission is simple, the impact immense!

Goals:

- To give children with life-threatening or chronic conditions a way to express their creativity.
- To make hospital stays and treatments less stressful for children and their families by providing them with arts and crafts activities.
- To give volunteers meaningful, enjoyable, ability-appropriate, and necessary tasks that contribute to the mission.

Bags of Smiles are distributed by volunteers to children in hospitals. Volunteers, often children, decorate each bag, which includes Play-Doh, homemade journals and cards, crayons, craft kits, and other selected items. Coping kits—arts and crafts sets—are supplied to hospitals and clinics for children undergoing lengthy treatments. Bags of Smiles and Coping Kits help the child focus on a fun activity during their hospital stay or as they go through their treatments.

Success of Caitlin's Smiles

Last year Caitlin's Smiles celebrated their 20th Anniversary. Over that time volunteers have:

- Bags of Smiles - decorated close to 200,000 Bags of Smiles
- Craft and Coping Kits - Prepared close to 2,130,000 (yes million) craft and coping kits.
- States and Hospitals - The reach now extends to nine states and over 70 hospitals or pediatric outpatient clinics!

Volunteers are the lifeblood of Caitlin's Smiles

The organization relies on volunteers for support due to its limited number of staff members. So... what can we do as a congregation? Starting January 12th, followed by the 2nd Monday of each month, volunteers will meet from 6:00-7:30 in the Mt. Olivet Room to decorate bags and cards and prepare craft kits. **Church members, friends, and all ages welcome!** Closer to the date, a sign-up sheet will be available on the table across from the mailboxes.
