Please include in the memo line your donation and designated to Operation Christmas Child. A donation of \$10 should be in an envelope and put in the box on the top of what is being sent.

On the display table you will find a flyer to indicate the gender and the age of the child that you choose. This should be affixed to the lid of the box. There are further guidelines as to what to pack and what not to pack on the website for Operation Christmas Child. There will be flyers on the display table, as well. Boxes will be available on the table with the display and can be returned as soon as they are packed. Each shoebox prayerfully packed full of fun gifts is an opportunity for the Gospel to transform the life of a child, family or a community. The shoe boxes are distributed to children around the world. For some children, it is the first time that they have received a gift and some go on to participate in follow up discipleship program, the Greatest Journey.
