We strive to offer developmentally appropriate learning for all of our preschool classes. Generally speaking, children attend the class for the age they are on Sept. 1. Sometimes parents know in advance that their child will not be attending Kindergarten the year they are 5 on Sept. 1. In this case, we recommend thatchildren be placed with the class with which they will enter Kindergarten.

#### **Food Allergies**

All Children's Ministry programs and areas are NUT FREE. All snacks must be pre- approved by Rainey Smith. Please ask before bringing snacks to share. Register your child and provide your child's food allergy information.

# Would a little extra support help your child fully participate? Because children learn differently and have different needs, all of our preschool and elementary classrooms include:

- "Fidgets" for children who need something to do with their hands in order to self-calm or to help with focus
- Visual schedules with pictures of the day's activities
- Sensory cushions provide active seating for wigglers while improving focus.

#### **Elementary**

1st - 5th Grade

Children will explore the weekly Bible story. The children are in groups depending on their grade level.

# Worship

#### Preschool and Elementary @ Worship

Children sometimes find it difficult to sit through the entire worship service without wiggling, fidgeting and losing interest. In order to help children and parents make the most of the worship experience, Children's Ministry offers these resources:

- Nursery for children through kindergarten age during worship.
- Sensory Room an extension of our sanctuary for members and guests to retreat
  to when participating in a group setting becomes overwhelming. This room is for
  our disabled community only.
- Cry Room located in the Nursery Hallway in Rm 140. Worship is streamed live on a large screen for families with sad infants and/or enthusiastic toddlers.
- Fidgets These are not intended as toys for every child but are provided for children who need a little something extra to do with their hands during worship.
   Please return "fidgets" at the end of worship.
- Children's Bibles Children's Bibles ranging from easy to older readers are available for Children to borrow during worship. Located on a table in the Narthex.
   Please return Bibles at the end of worship.
- Spark Activity pages for Pre-Reader and Reader are available in the Narthex along with a clipboard and pencil. Please return the clipboard and pencil at the end of worship.

# **Faith Stepping Stones**

These are times when your child "steps" from one developmental stage to the next. As they step forward physically, mentally, emotionally and educationally, our goal is that they step forward spiritually as well.

#### Each Faith Stepping Stone includes four elements:

**Naming:** We identify and recognize the event to give it holy significance.

**Equipping:** Adults and children (as they are able) learn stories, skills and habits that encourage growth in faith appropriate to the event.

**Celebrating:** In worship, community and at home through liturgy and time together, the congregation recognizes the new faith stage.

**Gifting:** The child receives a tangible symbol of the event as a reminder of its holy significance.

   2 year olds, beginning Sunday School, will receive a Beginner's Bible to take home and read together with their

family.

- Into Worship August
   Children entering 1st grade will meet with Miss Rainey to explore worship from an age appropriate perspective.
   The children will receive an Into Worship Lanyard and be recognized during worship.
- Into Communion January
   Communion Education is for second graders and older. Children will decorate a white stole keepsake.

- Into the Bible September
   2 workshops for 3rd graders and older on how to navigate through the Bible.
   Children are presented with a Children's Bible and decorate a Bible cover.
- Into Confirmation September Youth entering 6th Grade will begin confirmation classes. Youth will receive a Lutheran Study Bible at their preferred worship service.
- Out in Faith October
   Youth will celebrate their Confirmation on Reformation Sunday.
- Into the World May
   On Mother's Day, graduating High
   School Seniors participate with their
   families in a Flanket Ceremony.

#### 2024–2025 Stepping Stones Details and Dates

#### Into the Bible - September

Bible Education: 3rd grade and older

Children will receive a children's Bible during worship. During their Stepping Stone SundaySchool Workshops, children will personalize those Bibles, explore the different parts, learn how to find specific passages, and to use the "helps" that are provided. The goal of the workshops is for children to feel comfortable using their Bibles and be encouraged to use them regularly.

**September 15<sup>th</sup>:** Presentation of Bibles during worship.

Sept. 15<sup>th</sup> & 22<sup>nd</sup>: Into the Bible Workshops during the Sunday School hour in Rm 213.

#### Into Communion – January/February

Communion Education & First Communion: 2nd grade and older

At King of Glory, the age at which children begin communion is a family decision. We acknowledge that children mature at different ages and that some parents have strong preferences as to the appropriate age for children to begin. Each year we offer a multi-week Communion Education class for children in second grade and above whose parents have determined that their child is ready. This year, the Communion Education series will be offered on Sundays in January. Children will explore communion as instituted by Jesus at the Last Supper and the meaning of communion from a Lutheran perspective.

- January 19<sup>th</sup>, 26<sup>th</sup>, February 2<sup>nd</sup>: Communion Education Classes during the Sunday School hour.
- February 9<sup>th</sup>: Celebration Breakfast during the Sunday School hour followed by First Communion Celebration during worship.

#### Illness Policies and Procedures

#### What you can do:

Stay home if you or your child is not feeling well or has any of the following symptoms:

- Fever (temperature 100.4 °F or higher)
- Sore throat
- New uncontrolled cough that causes difficulty breathing (for a child with chronic allergic/asthmatic cough, see if there is a change from their usual cough)
- Diarrhea, vomiting, or stomachache
- New onset of severe headache, especially with a fever
