SPIRITUAL GIFTS OVERVIEW

“There are different kinds of gifts,
but the same Spirit distributes them.
There are different kinds of service,
but the same Lord.
There are different kinds of working,
but in all of them and in everyone
it is the same God at work.”

1 Corinthians 12: 4-6



MUSIC - Vocal

The gift that gives a believer the capability and opportunity to present personal witness and inspiration to others through singing.

People with this gift are usually **expressive, imaginative, insightful, inspiring, reflective, sensitive, creative, studious, truthful, observant.**

Cautions for people with this gift:

Remembering that music is not for music's sake but to glorify God and edify others; finding evaluation and constructive criticism difficult to accept.

BIBLICAL REFERENCES

Psalms 96:1–9, Psalm 100:1–2, Psalm 149:1–2

Psalm 96:1-9

- 1** Sing to the LORD a new song;
sing to the LORD, all the earth.
- 2** Sing to the LORD, praise his name;
proclaim his salvation day after day.
- 3** Declare his glory among the nations,
his marvelous deeds among all
peoples.
- 4** For great is the LORD and most worthy
of praise;
he is to be feared above all gods.
- 5** For all the gods of the nations are idols,
but the LORD made the heavens.
- 6** Splendor and majesty are before him;
strength and glory are in his sanctuary.
- 7** Ascribe to the LORD, all you families of
nations,
ascribe to the LORD glory and strength.
- 8** Ascribe to the LORD the glory due his
name;
bring an offering and come into his
courts.
- 9** Worship the LORD in the splendor of his
holiness;
tremble before him, all the earth.

Psalm 100:1-2

1 Shout for joy to the LORD, all the earth.

2 Worship the LORD with gladness;
come before him with joyful songs.

MUSIC - Instrumental

The gift that inspires a believer to express personal faith and provide inspiration and comfort through the playing of musical instruments.

People with this gift are usually **expressive, imaginative, insightful, inspiring, reflective, sensitive, creative, studious, truthful, observant.**

Cautions for people with this gift:

Failing to see that their gift is significant and one that makes a spiritual contribution to the body of Christ; remembering that music is not for music's sake but to glorify God and edify others.

BIBLICAL REFERENCES

Psalm 33:1–5, Psalm 150, 1 Samuel 16:14–23

Psalm 33:1-5

- 1** Sing joyfully to the LORD, you righteous;
it is fitting for the upright to praise him.
- 2** Praise the LORD with the harp;
make music to him on the ten-stringed lyre.
- 3** Sing to him a new song;
play skillfully, and shout for joy.
- 4** For the word of the LORD is right and true;
he is faithful in all he does.
- 5** The LORD loves righteousness and justice;
the earth is full of his unfailing love.

1 Samuel 16:14-23

14 Now the Spirit of the LORD had departed from Saul, and an evil^[a] spirit from the LORD tormented him.

15 Saul's attendants said to him, "See, an evil spirit from God is tormenting you. **16** Let our lord command his servants here to search for someone who can play the lyre. He will play when the evil spirit from God comes on you, and you will feel better."

17 So Saul said to his attendants, "Find someone who plays well and bring him to me."

18 One of the servants answered, "I have seen a son of Jesse of Bethlehem who knows how to play the lyre. He is a brave man and a warrior. He speaks well and is a fine-looking man. And the LORD is with him.".....< scripture continues next slide >

1 Samuel 16:14-23

19 Then Saul sent messengers to Jesse and said, "Send me your son David, who is with the sheep." **20** So Jesse took a donkey loaded with bread, a skin of wine and a young goat and sent them with his son David to Saul.

21 David came to Saul and entered his service. Saul liked him very much, and David became one of his armor-bearers. **22** Then Saul sent word to Jesse, saying, "Allow David to remain in my service, for I am pleased with him."

23 Whenever the spirit from God came on Saul, David would take up his lyre and play. Then relief would come to Saul; he would feel better, and the evil spirit would leave him.
