WHAT IS THERE FOR CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE?

We have Bible Studies every Sunday and many more gospel-focused activities to entertain children and youth of all ages!

Children ages up to Kindergarten receive care in the “Victory Village” Preschool area. Children ages 1 through 6 also have their Bible study time in the Children's Hallway classrooms. They must sign in at the Welcome desk, where they will receive a name tag and a similar tag will be given to parents. Only with this tag you can pick up your children. If it's your first time, come a few minutes early to register with us!

During the time of the Worship Service (10 to 11:30 am), children up to 3 years old can stay and receive care while their parents participate in the service.

Our AWANA Club, (for ages 3-6), presents Bible stories and games, every Wednesday from 5:55-7:30 pm, throughout the school year. It is a great place for children to learn to connect with God, His Word, and with others. We also have fun theme nights all year long!!

Students in grades 7-12 also have a fun and enriching time in our Student Ministry. In addition to times of games, entertainment and sharing with each other, they share the Word of God and are always pushed to know and love Christ more.
