Palmer Memorial Episcopal Church Finance Committee Meeting Minutes of January 12, 2023

A. Opening

- 1. Attendance: Jessica Evans, Pam Harvey, Ryan Hawthorne, Kip Krause, Dave Maxey, David Robinson, Dick Sylvan, Dick Viebig, Kirk Waldron, Neil Willard, Larry Wood
- 2. Neil W. opened the meeting with a prayer.
- 3. The minutes of the December meeting of the finance committee were moved for approval by Dick V., seconded by Kip K., and approved by all.

B. Financial Reports

- 1. Larry W. opened with a discussion on year end cash balances. 2023 prepaid pledges were well above average at ~\$268k.
- 2. Dick V. noted that pledge revenues fell short for the year at ~\$78k. Compared to prior years this is disappointing.
- 3. Neil. W offered to review the list of remaining unpaid pledges and take any necessary action. Jessica E. will provide this list to Neil W. and David R. for analysis.
- 4. Larry W. reviewed total expenses and noted that expenses were under budget for the year at ~\$120k. This was due mostly to cost savings in the personnel lines.
- 5. Larry W. moved to approve submission of the December financial statements to the Vestry, Dick V. seconded and the motion was approved by all.

C. 2023 Pledges

- 1. Jessica E. reviewed the 2023 pledges report with the committee. Current pledges are at \$1,485,481, 27 pledges and \$55k short of 2022.
- 2. Larry W. and several others highly praised the diligent efforts of the stewardship committee.

D. 2023 Budget

- 1. Larry W. noted that the prepaid revenues should be updated to reflect the actual number received.
- 2. The committee agreed to reduce pledge revenues by \$100k to be more realistic. This will still result in deficit budget for 2023.
- 3. The budget subcommittee will meet the week of January 23rd and discuss potential cuts to expenses. A revised budget will be provided to the committee prior to February's finance committee meeting.
