"In the midst of seas of change, our God is an unchanging Rock."
 In Exodus 3 God was trying to enlist a Moses to lead His people out of slavery in Egypt
 Moses asks the question: "who am I" – Exodus 3:11
 Moses then asks the question: "who are you" – Exodus 3:13
• God responds "I AM WHO I AM" – Exodus 3:14

 Abraham was given a promise and though unlikely, He God – Genesis 15:6, Romans 4:21, Psalm 119:89
2. <u>His</u> <u>Never Change</u> – v. 17
Unchangeable means: and unalterable
 Abraham even obeyed when asked to his son and God confirmed His promise – Genesis 22:16-17
 You and I change our all the time, but God's purposes never change – Isaiah 14:24
