- B. "in front of the mountain"
 - 1. There are two Mt. Sinai
 - 2. They "camped" there for a year

III. THE INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE MEETING v.3-9

- A. The LORD called to Moses from the mountain v.3
 - 1. "called"
 - 2. Do you remember the other time God called to Moses from this mountain?
 - 3. Do you remember the sign God gave to Moses about this mountain in Exodus?
- B. God's words to the Israelites v.4-8
 - 1. "You yourselves have seen"
 - 2. "What I did to the Egyptians"
 - 3. "and how I bore you on eagles' wings"
 - 4. "and brought you to Myself"

- 5. What is God bringing about through these words and memories?
- C. God's promise to the people v.5, 6
 - 1. "If you will indeed obey my voice and keep my commandments"
 - 2. "then you shall be my own possession"
 - 3. "and you shall be to Me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation" v.6
 - 4. Compare the results with who we are in Christ
- D. The response of the people v. 7,8
 - 1. Moses set before the people all the words of God v.7
 - 2. "All the people answered together" v.8
 - 3. "All that the LORD has spoken we will do"

- A. God told Moses He would come to him in a thick cloud
 - 1. "thick cloud"
 - 2. Notice why God was doing this v.9
- B. Moses was to "consecrate" the people v.10
 - 1. "wash"
 - 2. Why were they to be consecrated?
- C. The people were to be ready on the third day for God to come down v.10, 11
- D. Boundaries were to be set around the mountain v.12, 13
 - 1. What would the boundaries indicate to the people?

- 2. They were not to go up or touch the mountain
- E. Moses went down and told the people v.14, 15
- F. The LORD came down v. 16
 - 1. "when it was morning" v.16
 - 2. "thunder and lightning flashing"
 - 3. "a thick cloud"
 - 4. "a very loud trumpet"
 - 5. The people "trembled"
 - 6. Why?
- G. "Moses brought the people out of camp to meet God" v.17
 - 1. What position would this action give Moses?
 - 2. We have a mediator in Christ whom through we can come to God

V. THE LORD SPOKE WITH MOSES v.18-25

- A. Mt. Sinai was all in smoke
 - 1. "Because the LORD descended upon it in fire"
 - 2. "the whole mountain quaked violently"
 - 3. Imagine that scene as the people were watching
 - 4. What would this do with the commitment they had made in v.8?
- B. The LORD called Moses to come up to the top of the mountain v.19, 20
- C. The LORD's words to Moses
 - 1. "Go down and warn the people" v.21
 - 2. Also the priests v.22

- 3. Moses was to go down and come up again with Aaron v.24, 25
- D. What stands out to you about this incident?
 - 1. How would you have responded if you were the people?
 - 2. How would you have responded if you were Moses?

VI. LESSSONS FOR US FROM THIS MEETING

- A. God is a holy God
- B. There must be a humbling of ourselves before God
- C. God came down to meet them
- D. God's grace is amazing
- E. To meet with God we must prepare ourselves
 - 1. By our commitment
 - 2. By our consecration
 - 3. By our washing of our "garments"
 - 4. By the humbling of ourselves

 - 5. A focus upon self
 - 6. Forgetfulness
