## **Monthly Lessons At-A-Glance**

### **Sunday (Bible Studies for Life)**

Unit Theme: People can trust God

Bible Passages: Ruth chose to help Naomi (Ruth 1-2); Hannah prayed (1 Sam 1); A widow helped Elijah (1 Kings 17); Esther helped her people (Esther 2-8)

### **Wednesday (Gospel Project)**

Unit Theme: Hope to Come

Bible Passages: Ezra and God’s Law (Ezra 7-10, Neh 8); People worshipped God (Neh. 7-13); Prophet Malachi and God’s love (Malachi); Old Testament points to Jesus (Luke 1, John 1)

### **To Do at Home:**

Review Parent Page

Ask follow-up questions, like:

What did you learn about God today?

How will this truth about God help you this week?

How can I pray for you in light of this lesson?

*Younger Kids (0 - Kindergarten):*

What happened in the Bible account you heard today?

What was the Big Idea of the lesson?

How can I pray for you?
