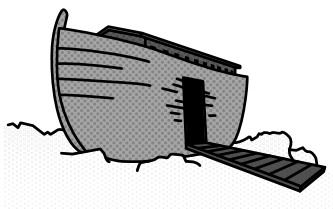


## Did You Know?

# REMEMBER EVERYDAY

Noah left the Ark remembering how God had saved them from the flood. Everyday he remembered. How can you remember everyday just how faithful God is to you? Below you will find scriptures you can read and questions to think about. Do one everyday!



## DAY 1 SMART CHOICES

**Proverbs 4:14-15** It says we should stay away from things that can get us into trouble, like the **Danger Zone**. What are some things that might not be good for us? How can we make smart choices? Let's ask God to help us make wise decisions.

## DAY 2 NOAH LISTENED TO GOD

**Genesis 6:22**  
**Genesis 7:5**

These verses tell us how Noah listened to God and did what He said. When we obey God, it's like making good choices, just like Noah. Can you think of a time when you listened to your parents or teachers and it turned out well? Thank God for guiding us.

## DAY 3 THE RAINBOW & GOD'S PROMISE

**Genesis 9:13-16**

God uses a rainbow to remind us of His promises. What do you think about when you see a rainbow? Think about God's promises and say thank you to Him for always keeping them.

## DAY 4 DOING GOOD & GOD'S PROMISES

**Deuteronomy 28:1-2**

It talks about doing good, and God's blessings. Can you think of something good you've done recently? How did it make you feel? Pray and ask God to help us do good things every day.

## DAY 5 BELIEVING IN GOD EVEN WHEN WE CAN'T SEE HIM

**Hebrews 11:1**

It's about having faith, like believing in something even if we can't see it. Can you think of something you believe in without seeing? Think about how you can trust God even when we can't see Him, and we'll ask God to help our faith grow.
