- 1. Write a special message to God on the paper
- 2. Roll the paper up
- Find a place you can put the rolled up paper, like in a fence or a crack in a brick wall. If you can't find anything like that, just find a spot in the house.

- 2. Pray for that person
- 3. Draw a cross on a piece of paper and put the Band Aid on the cross

PRAY FOR KINDNESS Take a clothespin and...



- 1. Write the name of someone you need to be kind to on a piece of paper
- 2. Pray for that person
- 3. Hang the paper on a string with the clothespin
