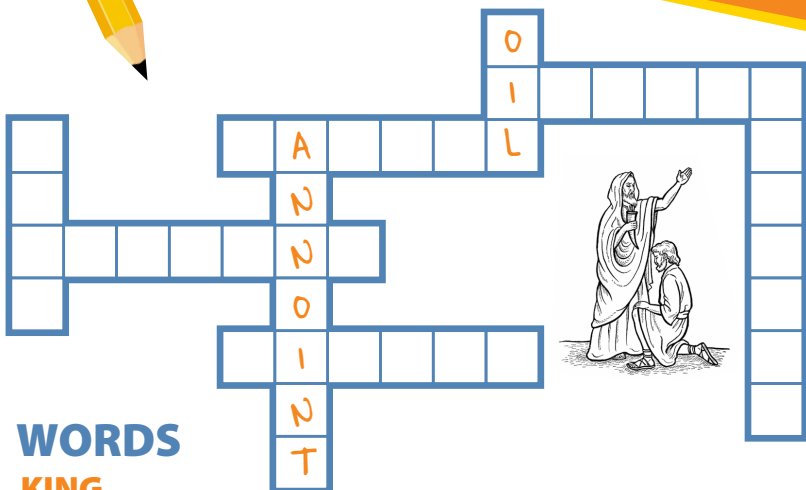

Crossword

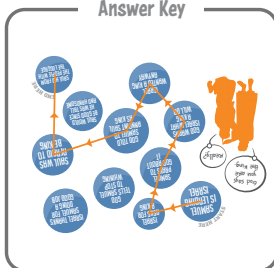
