Heidelberg Catechism, Q&A 77

Leader: Where has Christ promised that He will feed and nourish believers with His body and blood as certainly as they eat of this broken bread and drink of this cup?

Congregation: In the institution of the Supper, which says: “The Lord Jesus in the night in which He was betrayed took bread; and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, ‘This is My body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of Me.’ In the same way He took the cup also after supper, saying, ‘This cup is the new covenant in My blood; do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me. For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord’s death until He comes.’”¹ This promise is also repeated by the Apostle Paul, where he says: “Is not the cup of blessing which we bless a sharing in the blood of Christ? Is not the bread which we break a sharing in the body of Christ? Since there is one bread, we who are many are one body; for we all partake of the one bread.”²
