Luke 24:1-12

Introduction: In this sermon, we seek to ground our faith, even when we struggle, in the truth of the resurrection of Jesus.

Lord, despite our circumstances, help us put our resurrection hope in you.

Sunday Text Questions

Luke 24:1-12

April 20, 2025

Pastor Mickey Klink

Read the text aloud and discuss any significant observations or issues needing clarification together.

- 1) Why are Good Friday and Easter important to practice annually for our spiritual lives?
- 2) The Sabbath in the Old Covenant was Saturday, but in the New Covenant it was changed to Sunday, “the first day of the week” (v. 1), because of the Resurrection. What guided the earliest Christians to see this change as biblically necessary? And what significance should Sunday have for Christians today?
- 3) The encounter between the women disciples and the two angels in vv. 4-8 is the core part of Luke’s resurrection account. What important truths do the angels’ statements teach us about Jesus’ resurrection?
- 4) Why did the other disciples, especially the Eleven, not believe the testimony of the women (vv. 9-11)? In what ways might people today struggle to believe in the resurrection of Jesus?
- 5) How does the resurrection of Jesus give us hope and confidence in our lives today?
- 6) In what other ways, if any, did this passage speak into your life to teach, rebuke, correct, or train you in righteousness (cf. 2 Timothy 3:16)?

Further study this week: Passages related to Easter: Mark 16 (Mon); Luke 24 (Tues); John 11 (Wed); John 20 (Thurs); 1 Corinthians 15 (Fri).
