Read the text aloud and discuss any significant observations or issues that need clarification together.

- 1) What has been your experience with evangelism and talking to people about Jesus? Is it difficult or easy for you?
- 2) Why does the apostle Paul call himself “the least of all the Lord’s people” (v. 8), and how does that reflect his humility before the Lord?
- 3) What is Paul talking about when he says he was assigned to preach to the Gentiles “the boundless riches of Christ” (v. 8)? How have you experienced the riches of Christ?
- 4) How do we “make plain to everyone” the gospel (v. 9)? How do you define “the gospel” and in what ways do you explain it to people?
- 5) Why did God decide to show God’s “manifold wisdom” to the spiritual forces in the heavenly realms “through the church” (10)? What does that teach us about the importance of the church to God?
- 6) How many Christians today seek to share the gospel with their friends, co-workers, and neighbors? How seriously do you take God’s command to tell others about Jesus?
- 7) What would help you or motivate you to share the gospel with people more regularly? Can you think of a person or two to whom you might talk about Jesus? Spend time praying that the Lord would help you share the gospel with others.
