## FROM THE PRINCIPAL

I read an article once that began this way: "Given the choice between getting \$1 now or \$2 a week from now, what would your child choose to do? His ability to wait for the larger reward could have a dramatic impact on how well he does in school."

The article went on to cite a recent study showing that self-disciplined students who could delay gratification outperformed their peers academically. In fact, self-discipline appeared to be a bigger predictor of academic gains than IQ!

According to one of the study's co-authors, parents (and teachers!) can help students develop self-discipline by "drawing a harder line when it comes to giving in to kids' demands, letting them experience frustration, and encouraging them to wait for or earn the things they want."

That's hard to do in the moment, because we don't like to see our kids unhappy or struggling. But much like daily exercise, we know that developing those "grit muscles" will pay off in the future!

REMINDER: The rebate period is coming to a close at the end of March. The earning period goes from April to March with rebates being distributed in May. Something to think about: How do you want your rebate applied? Choices are last payment in May, first payment for next school year or bank for 8th grade Washington DC trip (beginning in 5th grade).

Also, don't forget that the minimum rebate is now \$25. This is how much you need to earn after the 60/40% split. If your earnings are under the \$25 limit your rebate is absorbed back into the program. So, check your earnings if you think you might not be at your minimum. I am also happy to help you check. 












Our Easter Egg Hunt with crafts, snacks, and a devotion will be on **Sunday, April 2nd at 11:00AM**.
