Pastor Darrin's Report

- A Mission of Hope vision trip is being planned to the Dominican Republic, for 3 days during the
 week of 3/20/23. Pastor Darrin, Hannah, and another person yet to be determined will go on
 the trip to discern and understand the possibilities of bringing a team from Community of Grace
 in 2024.
- A decision has been made to reconfigure the Dream Big team to add Pastor Darrin, Mike Mathisen, and Mike Hamernick of CGLC, Nick Boehland from Magnusson Christian school, and Erik Macintyre of the Master's Institute.
- Pastor Darrin will be travelling with his wife, Angela to Arizona for the last of the LCMC LeaderCare retreats at the end of January.

Pastor Angie's Report

- The prayer chapel has 5 prayer stations for taking next steps with Jesus.
- February prayer focus will be healing.
- Planning is in progress for Lent, summer, and next year preaching outlines.
- Ash Wednesday services will be held at 10:30 am and 6:30 pm.
- Lenten services will be held on Wednesdays with a 4:30 pm traditional service and a 6 pm -6:30 pm family friendly service.
- Lenten Soup Supper will be available from 5 pm 6 pm. Choir practice and Refuge will continue at 6:30 pm on Wednesdays.
- A Valentine banquet will be held in February.
- Irina Orf will lead a Seder meal on the Wednesday before Easter.
- Good Friday services will include an 11:30 am traditional service and a 7:00 pm teen and adult service.

- A contribution of \$1,000.00 was given to the WBL Food Shelf in support of the 2023 Bearly Open.
- Monthly contributions for General Service and Missions in December were \$3,567.20, which is \$82.80 below the monthly expense outlay of \$3,650.00. Year to date contributions through December were \$32,939.41, which was below year-to-date expense outlay of \$43,800.00
