- **Read John 21:4-14.** What do you notice about Peter's actions here? What do you imagine he might have been feeling?
- **Read John 21: 15-19**. Why do you think Jesus and Peter used different words for love in this passage (from the Sunday sermon) Agape or Philo? What impact do you think this made on Peter? What impact does it have on you?

What do you think Jesus meant by: *feed my lambs,* take care of my sheep, * feed my sheep? What is similar, what's different in those commands?

In verses 18-19 Jesus warns Peter of the cost of what he was asking- and still he commanded: Follow me! What impact do you think this had on Peter after his former denial?

• **Read Philippians 1: 12-14** What do you think Paul is saying here? When have you seen willingness to suffer become in itself a witness to others?

Read Philippians 1: 3-11 over the group as a blessing, then share with each other what stood out to you in it. Thank God for these things.
