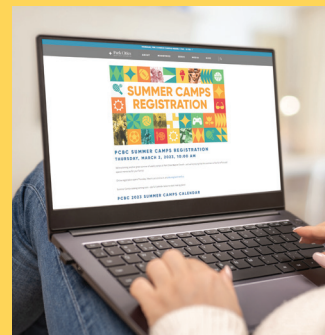

The ability to draw things as you SEE them is the first step toward becoming an artist. Having learned the fundamentals, the craft of drawing, you'll then have a solid point of departure from which to create. We will be focusing on correct proportions, contour drawing (the outline of a particular shape), a gray scale "value" chart (to learn how to render form and shape) and a few other tools of the trade.

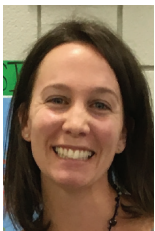
