


Sign up for Small Group Book Study During Sabbatical 2023

I will look forward to being a worshiper alongside you and have the chance to see you all again before resuming my day-to-day work on Monday, August 7.

I am exceedingly grateful for the tremendous staff and lay leaders we have at Central and I have no doubt that things will proceed in smooth and wonderful ways in my absence. I also appreciate the fact that Scott Woolridge will be present both throughout the week and on Sunday mornings to provide stability and support to everyone. 
HERITAGE CENTER OPEN HOUSE

love to pray with you and follow up, if you wish.


