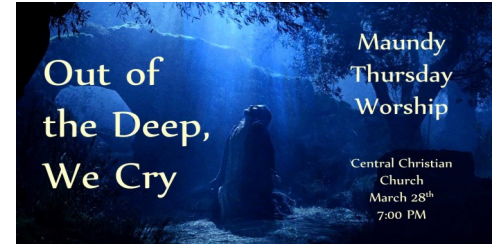
**3/28 – Maundy Thursday - 7 pm**
