"Do Not Grow Weary in Doing Good" 2 Thess. 3:13

Intro: In our verse the Apostle Paul exhorts the church in Thessalonica to persevere in doing good. It's not a command to not grow weary in doing good, it's an encouragement so they don't lose heart or grow weary in doing well, like Paul does in Galatians 6:9.
