- A main point of the sermon—righteousness
Matt. 5:6, 10, 20, 21-48; 6:33; 7:1-5, 15-19
- Israel thought they could establish your own righteousness
Romans 10:1-4
- The Righteousness required vs. 20
Gal. 3:10; James 2:10

Matt. 22:36-40: ³⁶“Teacher, which is the great commandment in the Law?” ³⁷And He said to him, “YOU SHALL LOVE THE LORD YOUR GOD WITH ALL YOUR HEART, AND WITH ALL YOUR SOUL, AND WITH ALL YOUR MIND.” ³⁸This is the great and foremost commandment. ³⁹The second is like it, ‘YOU SHALL LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR AS YOURSELF.’ ⁴⁰Upon these two commandments hang the whole Law and the Prophets.”

- Jesus came to fulfill the law vs. 17
Matt. 3:15; Romans 8:1-4; Gal. 3:13-14; Eph. 5:2
Heb. 9:14; 10:3-12; Gal. 4:45
