#### **Matt. 6:9-15**

- Pray, then, in this way
  - Matt. 6:4, 6, 8, 18; John 14:3; 17:1, 3-4, 6
  - Eph. 6:18-20; 1 Cor. 10:31; Col. 3:17; Matt. 6:13
- 3 petitions regarding ourselves and our dependance upon God
- Then our petition is
  - Give us this day our daily bread
    - God’s provision—our dependency**
  - And forgive our debts as we forgive our debtors
    - God’s pardon—our dependency**
  - And do not lead us into temptation but deliver us from evil
    - God’s protection—our dependency**
- Give us this day our daily bread vs. 11
  - God’s provision – our dependency**
  - Matt. 4:4; James 1:17; 4:13-17; Exodus 16:16-35
  - Matt. 6:25-34; Proverbs 30:8; Psalm 105:39-45
  - John 6:31-35; Heb. 4:16; 1 Cor. 2:12; John 3:27; Romans 12:3; 1 Cor. 15:10; Phil. 4:18-19; 2 Cor. 4:1, 16
- 1. God is the provider of all so we are dependent upon Him.
- 2. God is providing and has provided for us each day.
- 3. We all have a stewardship of what God gives.
- And forgive our debts as we forgive our debtor vs. 12

- The problem is sin
  - Sin makes us guilty and brings judgment
    - John 3:17-20; Romans 3:19-24; 1 John 3:4
    - Romans 6:23; Heb. 12:1-15
- The provision is forgiveness
  - Judicial forgiveness
    - Romans 3:21-26; 8:1, 33, 38-39; Psalm 103:11-12
    - Col. 2:13-14; Eph. 1:7
  - Parental forgiveness
    - Matt. 6:9; Isaiah 64:8; Luke 15:18, 21
    - Romans 8:15; 1 Peter 1:17; Psalm 51
    - 1 John 1:1-10; John 13:5-17
- The plea of confession – repentance
  - Psalm 51; 1 John 1; John 13:5-17
