### Mansions in Newport, RI

Day one you will travel to Danbury, CT, where you will spend the night. (Dinner on own).

Day two you will have breakfast at the hotel before you depart for Newport, RI. Enjoy some free time and lunch (on own) before you meet a local guide - Mrs. Caroline Astor, the Grande Dame of Newport, and New York Society in the Gilded Age of the late 1800's. Enjoy the charm of Newport's historic buildings and restored homes on this narrated tour covering over 150 points of interest.
